We look forward to once again working with all of you as we continue to prepare for the 26th Annual Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance, May 20-23, 2021.



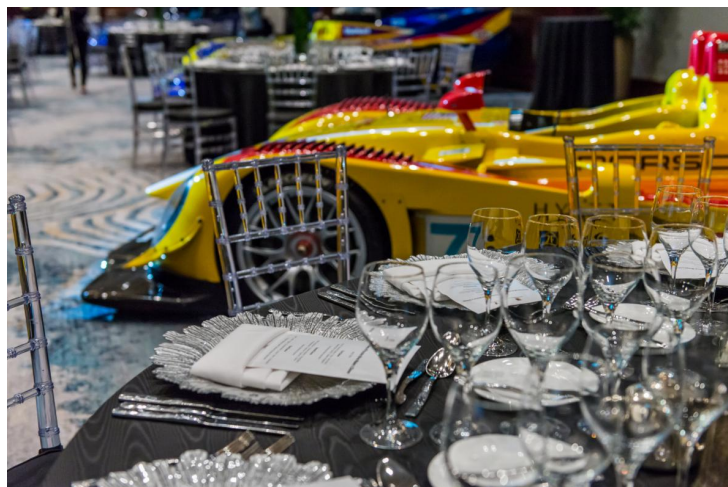
