CHEVY THUNDER CLASS SET TO SHAKE THE EARTH AND RATTLE WINDOWS AT THE 26TH ANNUAL AMELIA ISLAND **CONCOURS d'ELEGANCE**

Jacksonville, FL -- On May 23, 2021 the 26th annual Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance CHEVY THUNDER class dedicated to Chevy power will honor the cars and engines that made history, invested the average American motorist with the luxury of power on demand and created a muscular aura around Chevrolet's iconic "bowtie" emblem.

Chevy Thunder is still, as the famous slogan stated, "the heartbeat of America" from Indy (eleven "500" victories), the Daytona 500 (24 wins), Le Mans, Sebring, NHRA Pro Stock, IMSA GTP, GTO & GTX, Can-Am, Trans-Am, Sprint Cars, Baja & Desert racers, IROC, F5000, club racers, Swamp Buggies, Dune Buggies, Hot-Rods, kit cars and even to offshore powerboats. Chevy's small blocks, big-blocks and dedicated pure racing engines set records dominating practically every type of American motorsport for more than half a century.



Chevy's small block V-8 of 1955 is the elegantly simple engineering masterpiece that gave an almost effortless mobility to generations of American families. It also inspired and drove hot rodders and race car builders. Chevy small block power even sat on the front row of the Indy 500 (1981), outran the fabled Offys on America's dirt tracks and ruled NASCAR's high banks, short tracks and road courses. (The fuel-injected Chevy small block was so dominant in NASCAR racing during 1957 that it was banned.)

Small block Chevy Thunder enjoyed international reach winning the 24 Hours of Daytona, the 12 Hours of Sebring, the 1000 Km of the Nurburgring, the BOAC 6 Hours at Brands Hatch, owned the Can-Am (at one point winning 33 consecutive races), scored the **IMSA** GTO inaugural championship in 1971 and the IMSA GTP title in 1984.

Chevy Thunder is the soundtrack of NHRA Pro Stock competition winning the national title 24 times, more than any other manufacturer.

The Chevy V-8's impact on American culture extends well beyond automotive realms even entering popular music: in 1962 the Beach Boys composed a song commemorating the power and the social impact of Chevy's big block Turbo-Thrust V-8 entitled, appropriately, "409". Specifically songwriter Gary Usher's " . . . 4-speed, dual-quad, positraction four-ohnine!"

Since its first V-8 in 1917 (the "Series D" V8 engine of 1917-'19) Chevy V-8 power has touched practically every facet of American life powering cars and trucks, towing trailers, delivering groceries or taking the likes of Scarab, Chaparral, McLaren, Lola, Eagle, Corvette and Camaro to scores of racing victories and championships. Some Chevy V-8s even replaced a few of those pricey and legendary Italian V-12s in American sports car racing.



"The design and execution of Chevy's V-8 engines, especially the 'small block', is elegant without being exotic or exclusive," said Bill Warner, founder and Chairman of the Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance. "Simplicity, lightness, flexibility, compactness and economy are its core strengths. It's served long and well. And of course there's that unmistakable sound. Anyone who's ever attended a drag race, a NASCAR race, a Trans-Am or a Can-Am has heard, and sometimes felt, Chevy Thunder. It's the clear and unmistakable voice of American motorsports."
